

R Nursery Infants and toddlers are welcomed into the nursery as soon as parents are comfortable leaving them. We have very capable and loving volunteers to care for children every service. Our facilities are up to date, safe, and welcoming. The Infant Nursery is available for newborns and babies just learning to walk. The Toddler Nursery is full of activities for our active toddlers. Once a child is walking well, they are invited to join the toddler nursery until they are three years old. Also, a quiet private mother's room is available and connected to both nurseries for moms to care for their babies.



R Kids Worship The worship service for young children begins with the adults at 9:30 a.m. Children are then dismissed for Kids Worship at approx. 10:00 a.m. Their worship service ends at approx. 10:45, which is the same time as the adults. Children ages 3 through second grade leave partway through the Morning Worship Service to participate in a worship experience designed especially for them. This kid-friendly, age-appropriate program includes singing, a Bible lesson, and some fun, hands-on experiences. It's a great way to prepare little ones for the day when they are old enough to join the adult worship service.

R Kids Sunday School Sundays 11:00-12:00
We invite the whole family to attend Sunday School; a place to come to faith, grow in faith, and be encouraged to live in faith. Classes for all ages are held after the Morning Worship service in classrooms throughout our facility.



All Stars For Jesus Wednesdays from 6:45-8:00 p.m.
Wednesday nights during the school year we offer exciting, recreation-based Bible clubs for children through 6th grade. Here they will learn about the Bible, play games, and work on all kinds of badges. They will also have the opportunity to "cash in" points for prizes. Children will be mentored by caring adults and make lasting friendships with other kids.

This is an awesome week-long program for kids in Kindergarten through the 6th grade.
